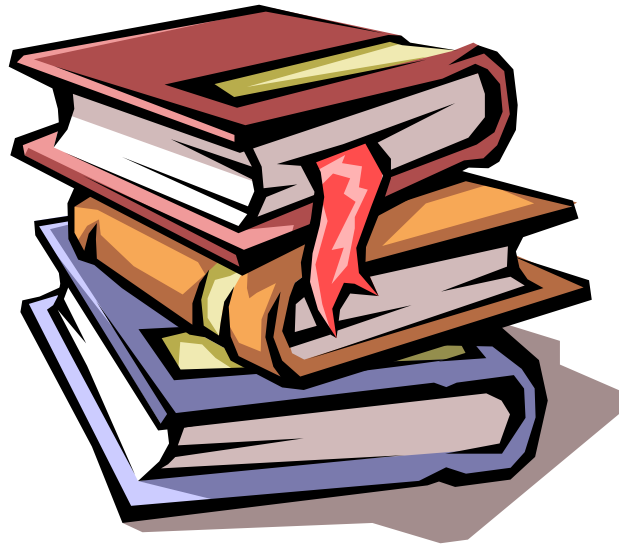

Audio Visual: There is a special video collection, in both VHS and Video 8 format, of building inspections and evaluations. Microfiche: There is a large collection of original and older building drawings on microfiche. Many of the CSA and CGSB standards are available in microfiche. There is a microfiche reader in the library and the Library Technician will assist those wishing to access material in this format.

The Technical Services Library

The Technical Services Library supports the work of engineers and architects in both the public and private sectors. The library, on the 3rd floor of the Stuart M. Hodgson Building, provides a spacious, bright and comfortable place for research and review of materials.



HOURS OF SERVICE

The Technical Services Library is open on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. At other times access may be requested from administrative support staff.

CIRCULATION

Materials from the Technical Services Library may be borrowed for four weeks. Reference materials, building drawings and operations and maintenance manuals are for library use only.

LIBRARY COLLECTION

Books, government publications and reports related to the work of the engineering and architectural professions, particularly in the north, are arranged by call number according to Library of Congress classification. There is a growing collection of standards and codes in hard copy as well as in microfiche format – including NRC, CSA, CGA, CGSB, Underwriters, NFPA, ASME, ASHRAE, and API.

Community Reports:

The library has a collection of NWT community reports and technical status evaluations including buildings; geotechnical and granular; and water and sanitation arranged alphabetically by community.

O&M Manuals:

There are Operations and Maintenance Manuals for buildings in each of the communities of the Northwest Territories. These are reference materials and therefore not available for loan but can be viewed in the library.

Drawings:

The building drawings, in mylar and blueprint format, pertain to educational and health care facilities; offices; recreational complexes and community halls; service buildings; airports and cultural/tourism facilities the Northwest Territories. The drawings are available as reference tools and may be viewed in the library. Arrangements to have drawings duplicated can be made with the Library Technician. Costs related to copying will be charged to either an index code for government departments or to the private firm requesting the copies.
